

## **Malcolm Brodie, Chair, National Zero Waste Council**

Malcolm Brodie is the Chair of the National Zero Waste Council, providing guidance to this cross-sector leadership initiative since its inception in October 2013. He has been a member of Richmond City Council since 1996, serving as the Mayor of Richmond since 2001. As a Metro Vancouver Director, Malcolm Brodie is also the Chair of the Zero Waste Committee and serves on the Intergovernmental & Finance Committee, the Mayors' Committee, the Performance & Procurement Committee, and the Federal Gas Tax Task Force.

Before election to Council, Mayor Brodie was a practicing lawyer and had a long record of service to Richmond in the volunteer community. In honour of his contributions and achievements in the community, Mayor Brodie was a recipient of the Commemorative Medal for the 125th Anniversary of the Confederation of Canada (1992), the Queen Elizabeth II Golden Jubilee Medal (2002), and the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal (2012).
