

Patrick Mulholland is a professional biologist (BSc, UBC, Aquacultural Science) who has been involved in composting for 20 years. In the early 1990s, Mulholland developed a full-scale fish composting system based in Port Alberni to handle large volumes of waste from the aquaculture industry. After moving to Squamish in 2003, he went to work with Carneys, developing sales and marketing strategies for its composting program. He has also implemented a quality assurance/control program for Carneys compost and product development. In 2008, Mulholland returned to this firm to complete the construction, and commissioning of the Whistler Compost Facility, a state-of-the-art, agitated, in-vessel composting system for biosolids and food waste. He is now responsible for overseeing all aspects of the facility's operations, maintenance and sales.
